Newborn life support (NLS) is intended to provide this help and comprises the following elements: Enabling placental transfusion (when able to do so) by delaying the clamping of the umbilical cord. Drying and covering the newborn infant, and where necessary taking additional steps, to maintain a normal body temperature (i.e. between 36.5°C and 37.5°C).

Approximately 5% to 10% of the newly born population require some degree of active resuscitation at birth (eg, stimulation to breathe), 1 and approximately 1% to 10% born in the hospital are reported to require assisted ventilation. 2 More than 5 million neonatal deaths occur worldwide each year.

For best survival and quality of life, pediatric basic life support (BLS) should be part of a community effort that includes prevention, early cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), prompt access to the emergency response system, and rapid pediatric advanced life support (PALS), followed by integrated post-cardiac arrest care.

Summary of changes in paediatric basic life support since the 2010 Guidelines The duration of delivering a breath is about 1 second, to coincide with adult practice. For chest compressions, the lower sternum should be depressed by at least one third the anterior-posterior diameter of the chest, or by 4 cm for the infant and 5 cm for the child.
