Therefore, the removal of the \$5,000 limit also applies to food stamp recipient households as explained in FSPG 63-203.18. Retirement and student accounts as described in this letter are also excluded as resources in the Food Stamp Program.

CalFresh Program Guide: Content Listing

CalWORKs is a public assistance program that provides cash aid and services to eligible families that have a child (ren) in the home. The program serves all 58 counties in the state and is operated locally by county welfare departments. If a family has little or no cash and needs housing, food, utilities, clothing or medical care, they may be eligible to receive immediate short-term help.

CalWORKS

The CalWorks food stamp program, also called CalFresh, is completely funded by the U.S. Department of Agriculture -- though California pays for half of the administrative costs -- and was put in place to help families pay for food if their incomes made that difficult.

Guidance to CWDs on how to handle cases when the whereabouts of an AU/household is unknown, because of returned mail, etc. Of note, for CalWORKs, residence in the state, but not in the county, is a requirement for continued eligibility for aid, and so AUs may not be automatically discontinued for “whereabouts unknown.”.

Adults in the program are required to participate in a work activity unless determined exempt.

Physically and mentally “unfit” for employment as defined by the state agency; but the state may not define unfitness less restrictively than it does for its TANF [CalWORKs] program. Already a rule in the Food Stamps program, and CalWORKs through Food Stamp simplification (MPP Sect. 42-213.2) the letter also instructs counties that both the principal and interest in 401 (k), 403 (b) and 457 retirement plan accounts are exempt from consideration as property for both CalWORKs applicants and recipients.

ACL 08-11: CalWORKs And Food Stamp Program: Changes In ...

The California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs) program is California's version of the Federal Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) program. This program provides time-limited cash assistance to low-income families with children under age 19. Adults may receive temporary cash aid for up to 48 months during lifetime.
