1. CHEMICALS (1) Overview of Chemical Substances Control ...

A person who intends to manufacture or import a new chemical substance shall notify it to three ministries at least three months prior to the manufacture or importation. The three ministries are the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry (METI), the Ministry of Labor and Welfare (MHLW), and the Ministry of the Environment (MOE).

This law is commonly known as the "Chemical Substances Control Law" (CSCL), and is administered by Japan's Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry (METI). The CSCL was amended in April 1986, and most recently in June 2003.

The Korean Toxic Chemicals Control Act (TCCA) was implemented in 1991 by the Ministry of Environment (MOE) for the overall management and control of industrial chemicals in Korea. The latest revised version (Act No.895) took effect on 21 Mar 2008. The purpose of this Act is to prevent any risk caused by chemicals to human health.

Arrangements regarding the use of chemicals and prohibition the use of chemicals as chemical weapons aimed at preventing and combating the misuse of chemicals as chemical weapons. This regulation mandates everyone who create, produce, possess, store, transfer or use of schedule 1, schedule 2 and schedule 3 chemicals shall submit a report at least once a year.

Since its enactment in 1973, it has imposed strict pre-marketing evaluation of chemical substances to prevent environmental pollution and control chemical risks to human health, plants and animals. It has been amended 3 times in 1986, 2003 and 2009.

The Japan Chemical Substances Control Law (CSCL) was firstly enacted on 16 October 1973 to prevent environmental pollution and control chemical risks to human health. On April 28, 2020, the names of 16 substances were published by Japan’s Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare (MHLW) to be regulated under the Poisonous and Deleterious Substances Control Law (PDSCL). The substances are open for public comment until May 27, 2020.
