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If we measure the rotations as a function of wavelength and if, as we approach shorter wavelengths, the rotation rises to a maximum before changing sign, as it does with the trans isomer, $\lambda(17)$, then the compound is said to exhibit a positive Cotton effect. -cis/trans (E / Z) isomerism under photochemical conditions commonly leads to thermodynamically less stablecis-isomer -cis-isomer typically absorbs at a lower λ due to decreased conjugation b/c of non-bonded interactions-reactions come to photostationary state unless optical pumping

4 ISOMERISM IN ORGANIC COMPOUNDS Isomers are the compounds with the same qualitative and quantitative composition of elements, therefore their relative molecular weights and general formulas are identical, but their structures - including in the 3D arrangement - are different.

Isomerism in organic compounds

Hence Maleic must be cis and fumaric must be trans. E,Z SYSTEM OF NOMENCLATURE FOR GEOMETRICAL ISOMERS. If two high-priority groups are on the same side, the configuration is Z (German, Zusammen = together). If they are on opposite side, the configuration is E (German; entgegen = opposite)

Coordination Chemistry Coordination compounds • neutral coordination compounds include the metal and its bound ligands • the number of bonds in a coordination complex does not correlate with the formal oxidation state of the metal • coordination complexes can also be charged -complex cations or complex anions • in a complex ion, the ligands coordinated to the metal make up the primary
