IN THE SUPREME COURT OF FLORIDA CASE NO. SC 06-2104

Duane Owen was convicted of first-degree murder and sentenced to death for the 1984 stabbing death of a fourteen-year-old babysitter in Delray Beach. 1 The essence of the State's case against Owen consisted of inculpatory statements made by Owen while he was in police custody and under interrogation.

Duane Eugene Owen v. Florida Department of Corrections ...

Owen was sentenced to death following a jury's recommendation for death by a vote of ten to two. Owen v. State, 596 So. 2d 985, 987 (Fla. 1992). His sentence of death became final in 1992. Owen v. Florida, 506 U.S. 921 (1992). Thus, Hurst does not apply retroactively to Owen's sentence of death. See Hitchcock, 226 So. 3d at 217.
