If you have one make sure you replace the screen along with the switch. You will need a small pick to fish it out of the oil gallery in the engine block.

If your sensor is the only thing to go bad, and you do not have any actual engine knock, checking the CEL codes will be the best way to tell.

### How To Disable/Disconnect/Bypass a Low Oil Shutdown Switch ...

The first thing to do is open the hood and find where the oil sensor is located. You will find it in the engine, on the side of the driver seat near the oil filter. Using your hands, disconnect the harness sensor. Then, you should remove the oil sensor using an open-end wrench from the engine block.
