Guided reading is one component of a four-block reading program, developed by Pat Cunningham and Dottie Hall, which consists of self-selected reading, shared reading, writing, and working with words. Guided reading is one component of the shared reading block during which the teacher provides support for small, flexible groups of beginning readers.

Guided Reading is a small group instruction, which allows the teacher to provide explicit teaching and support for reading increasingly challenging texts. As the teacher targets and implements reading strategies that help guide and support the reader, students learn to think like proficient readers.

Traditional groups focus on the lesson, not the student — while guided reading focuses on the student, not the lesson which will actually help the student learn and comprehend the lesson plan quicker.; Traditional is grouped by general determination of ability — while guided is grouped by specific assessment for strengths and appropriate level of the text.
