Properties of Chemical Elements - Periodic Table

The trend in properties from the lighter to the heavier elements may be attributed to changes in the strength of binding of the outer electrons and especially to the increasing size of the atoms.

Periodic Trends in Properties of Elements Periodicity in Properties : The properties of elements depends upon the electronic configuration which changes along a period and down a group in periodic table. There is periodicity in properties, i.e., repetition of properties after a regular interval due to similarity in electronic configuration.

Chemical properties of the elements are periodic (repeating) functions of their atomic numbers. What it means: Elements are arranged in order of increasing atomic number across periods so that elements with similar chemical properties fall in the same group.
