Step 1 - Cut the Bubble Use a damp sponge and wet the wallpaper in the area needing wallpaper repair. Carefully cut the middle of the bubble with a razor blade in the shape of a cross cut. Be sure not to press too hard so you don’t damage the wall.

Most blisters and bubbles disappear after the wallpaper has had time to dry, so don't worry too much. After all, you now know all the tips and tricks as to how to get rid of them, just in case. Draw up a bit of wallpaper paste into the syringe. Then penetrate the bubble with the pointed needle and carefully squeeze the paste underneath the paper.

What can I do to prevent bubbles and blisters ... - Wallpaper

To repair bubbles, moisten the area with a clean, damp cloth. Using a utility knife or sharp razor blade, slit the bubble. Avoid making a straight cut—a V-shaped slit or one that follows the wallpaper’s pattern will conceal the cut and make gluing easier. With a narrow putty knife, force glue through the slit.

Here’s how to get rid of that bubble: Using a sharp utility knife, cut a small slit in the paper along one side of the bubble. Insert the injector’s needle into the slit, and squeeze seam adhesive...

No matter where the loose seam is or what caused it, the repair procedure is the same: Dip a small artist’s brush into wallpaper-seam adhesive (about \$3 for a 4-oz. tube at paint and wallcovering stores). Spread an even coat of adhesive onto the underside of the exposed seam (photo 1). Then use a wooden seam roller to flatten the seam (photo 2).

Puncture the bubble with a sewing needle. Press the vinyl with your fingers to push the air out and flatten the area. 2 Lay a towel over the punctured vinyl if you are working with flooring.

Cut the new patch oversize. Then tape the new paper (blue tape) directly over the existing wallpaper so the wallpaper patterns match. To establish the cutting lines, place marked pieces of tape (red tape) on the wall to mark the horizontal and vertical cutting lines. Lay a metal straightedge between these lines.

Flatten the paper against the wall using light pressure. Smooth out the bubble with a damp sponge. Wipe off any excess glue and allow the wallpaper repair to dry. Repeat this process on other wallpaper bubbles as necessary. Once completed, you can sit back and admire a job well done!

Fix Wallpaper Bubbles Greater Than an Inch Cut the letter X into the bubble with either a utility knife or razor then pull each section slightly away from the wall. Take a small amount of wallpaper paste and carefully cover the undersides of each section made from the cut. Firmly place the paper back on the wall to its original shape.

1 Before you begin, feel the bubble to ensure there’s nothing but air trapped under the wallpaper. If there’s something else, such as a bit of chipped paint, you’ll need to remove it before proceeding to step 2. 2 Using an X-acto knife, make a small incision in the paper.

Loose seams and bubbles are even easier to repair as long as you remember the most important secret — soften the wallpaper in and around the area of the repair first.

Roll a seam roller over the wallpaper and toward the slit, you cut in the bubble, with the razor knife. Stop at the slit, move to the opposite side of the bubble and repeat. Continue rolling each...

If your wallpaper is peeling, brush on seam adhesive to reattach it. For rips or punctures, seamlessly patch the paper and, if there are bubbles or bumps underneath your wallpaper, use a glue syringe to smooth them out. Method 1 Repairing Peeling Wallpaper Seams
