Sidereus nuncius, or, The Sidereal messenger

The Sidereus nuncius, a title commonly translated as the Starry messenger, is a book printed and published within a few months of the date of the observations it reported. The stimulus to Galileo's new observations and the haste to publish an illustrated book was the discovery made in about 1608 by opticians in the Low Countries that two lenses placed at the correct distance when their optical axes were in line gave a magnified image of distant objects, the founding principle of the telescope.
